Position Purpose and Description:

The KIKOP Project works to reduce the rates of infant, child, and maternal mortality in the Kitutu Chache Sub-County of Kisii, Kenya through community-driven health education and health facility improvements. The Program Intern – Kenya (PI) will work directly with Curamericas Global Program Manager and project staff to support the ongoing needs of KIKOP and Curamericas Global. PI projects will vary based on need, however it is anticipated that they will include the following:

- Monitoring and evaluation of the adolescent health program
- Creation of reports for donors, marketing and operational research
- Conduct literature reviews on health topics
- Assistance with project management tasks related to financial reporting/tracking, development of operational research materials, development of educational materials, new program development, etc.

All interns are asked to allocate a maximum of 15% of their time to assist with tasks outside of their immediate job description in order to meet urgent project needs and support the Curamericas Global team.

Selection Criteria:

- Junior, senior or recent graduate of undergraduate program in public health, international health, social sciences or related degree
- (Preferred) Currently enrolled in or graduate of a master's or other post-bachelor's degree in public health, international health, social sciences or related degree.
- Highly motivated and results oriented
- Flexible and open to doing whatever is needed to meet program goals
- Interest in program management and international community health practices and principles
