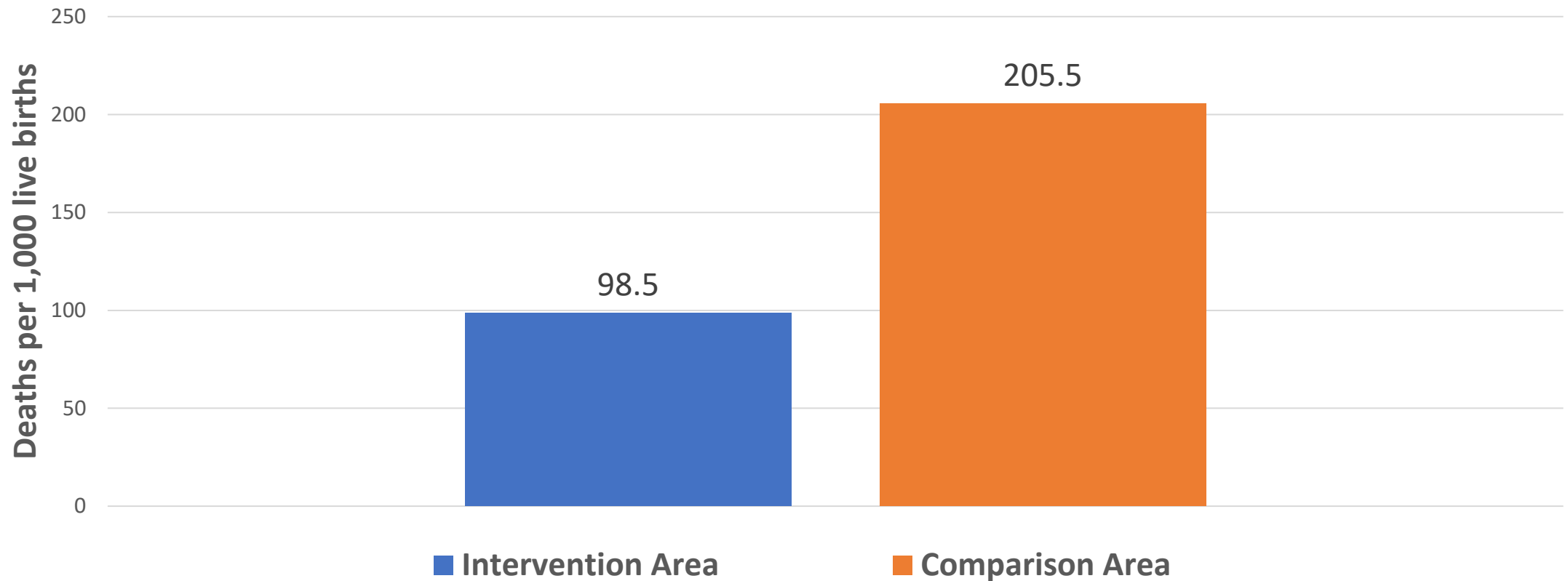

Decline in under-5 mortality in the Montero, Bolivia, project area, 1992-2018

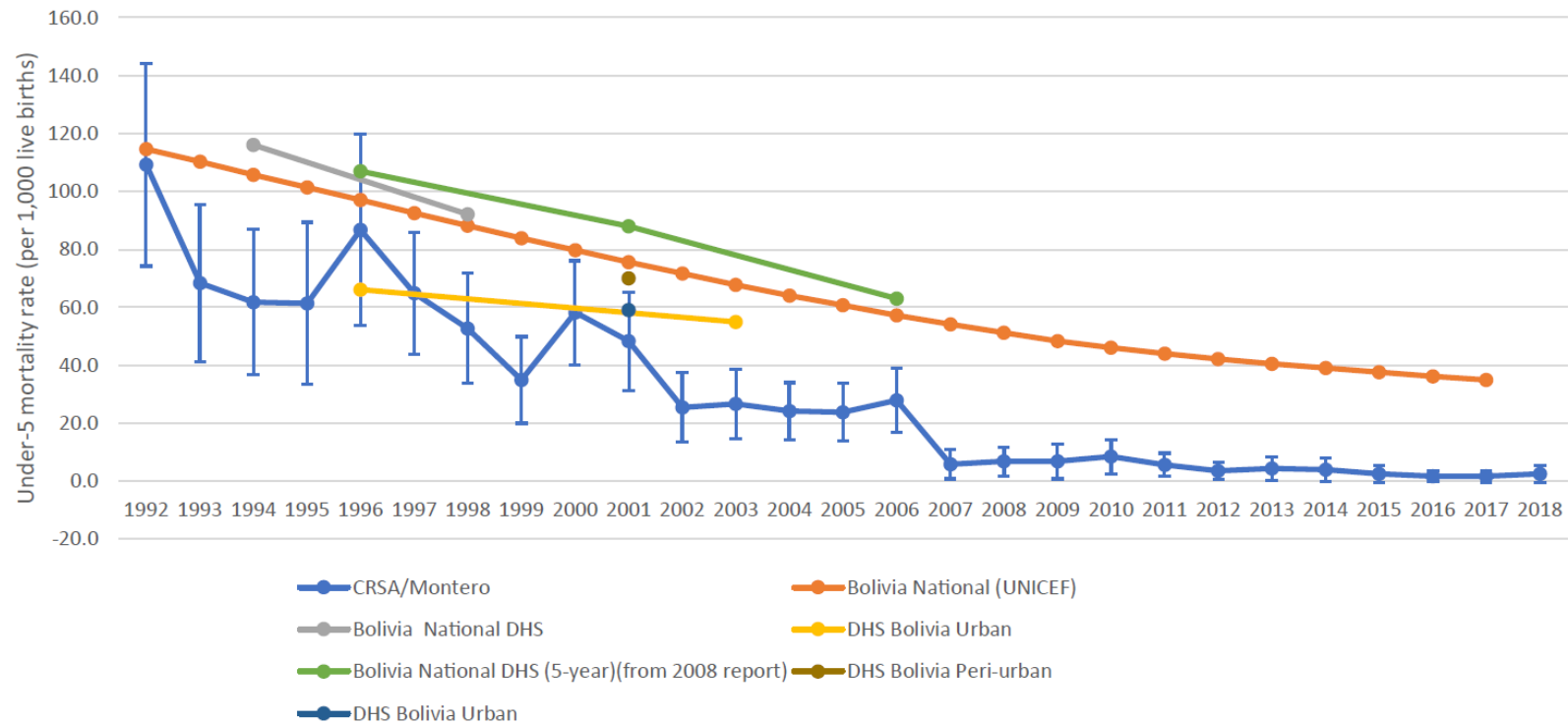
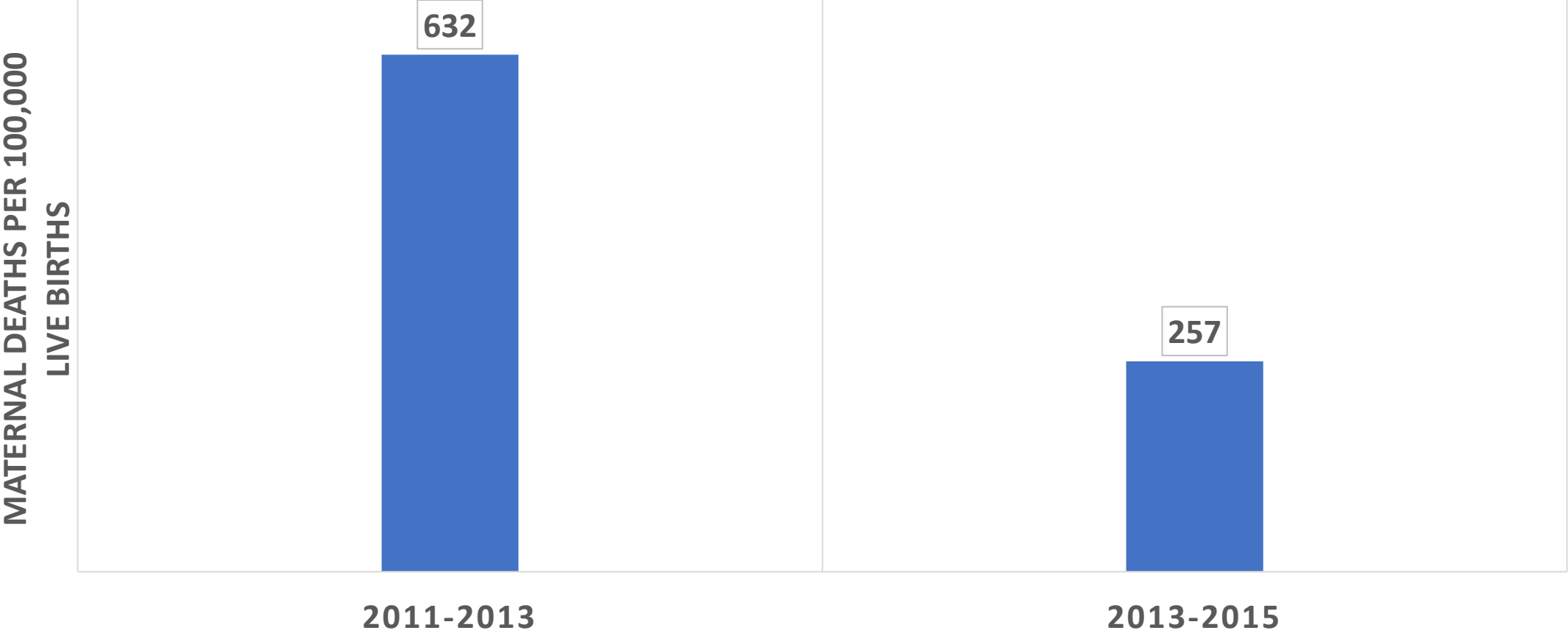


Figure 1. Long-term trends in under-5 mortality, CSRA/Montero Program area, 1992-2018, compared with those for Bolivia nationally, for the Department of Santa Cruz, and for urban Bolivia.

Under-5 mortality decline in the Guatemala project area, 2011-2015

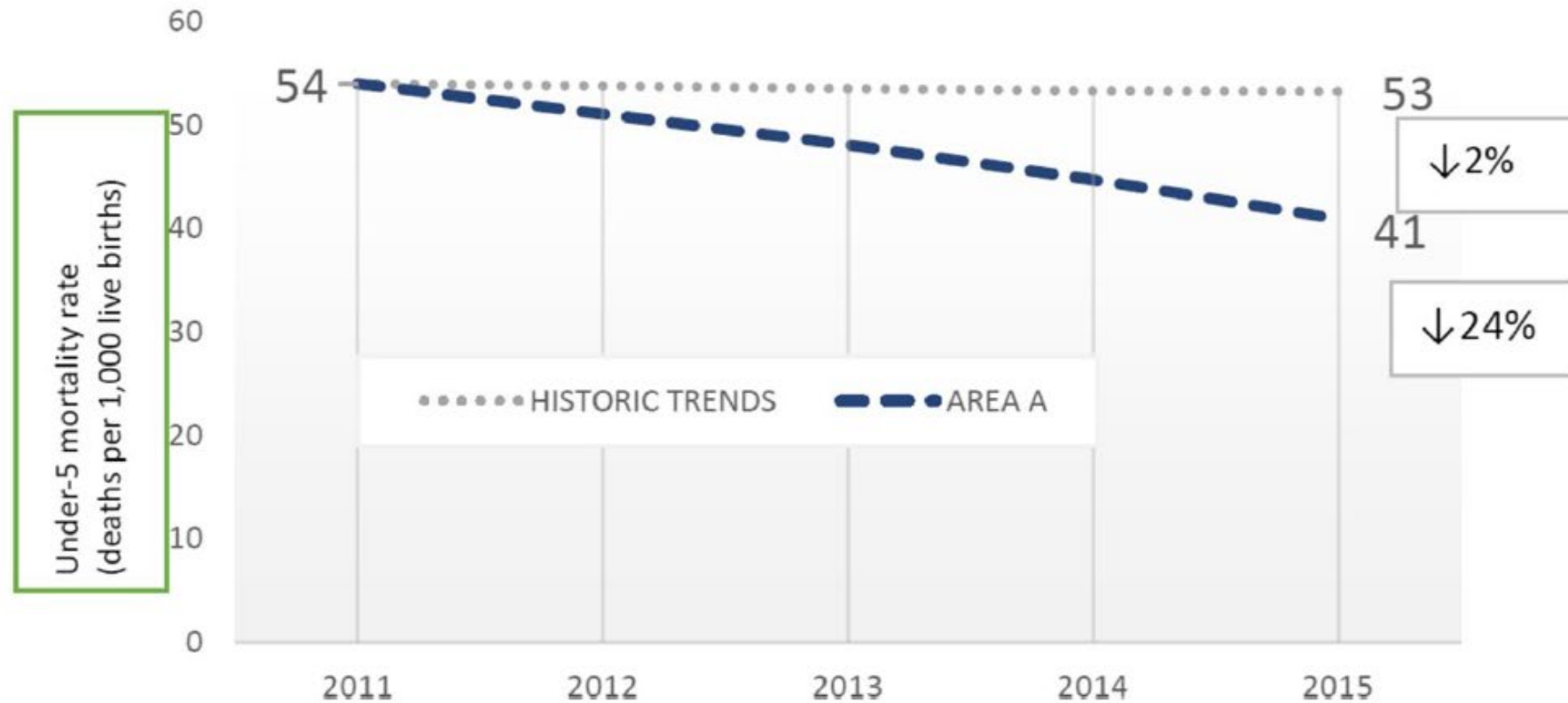


Fig. 15 Estimate of decline in 0- < 60 month mortality in Area A, 2011 to 2015, using the Lives Saved Tool, compared to estimated historical decline

Improvements in childhood stunting in the Curamericas/Guatemala project areas, 2011-2015

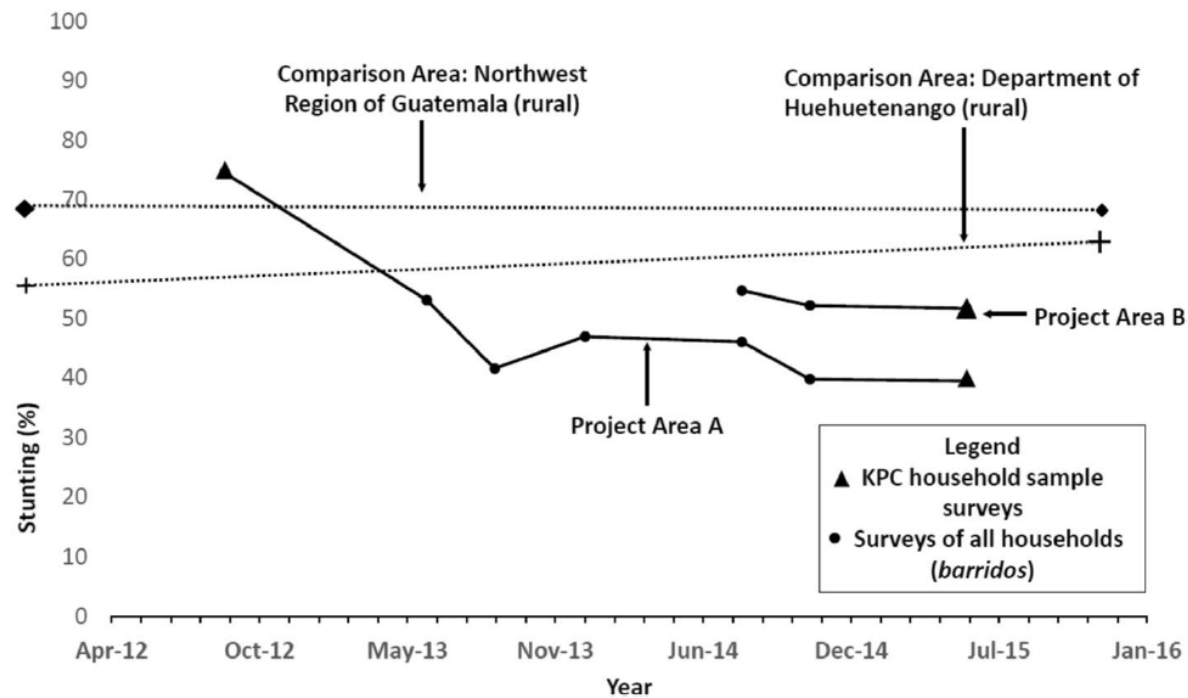
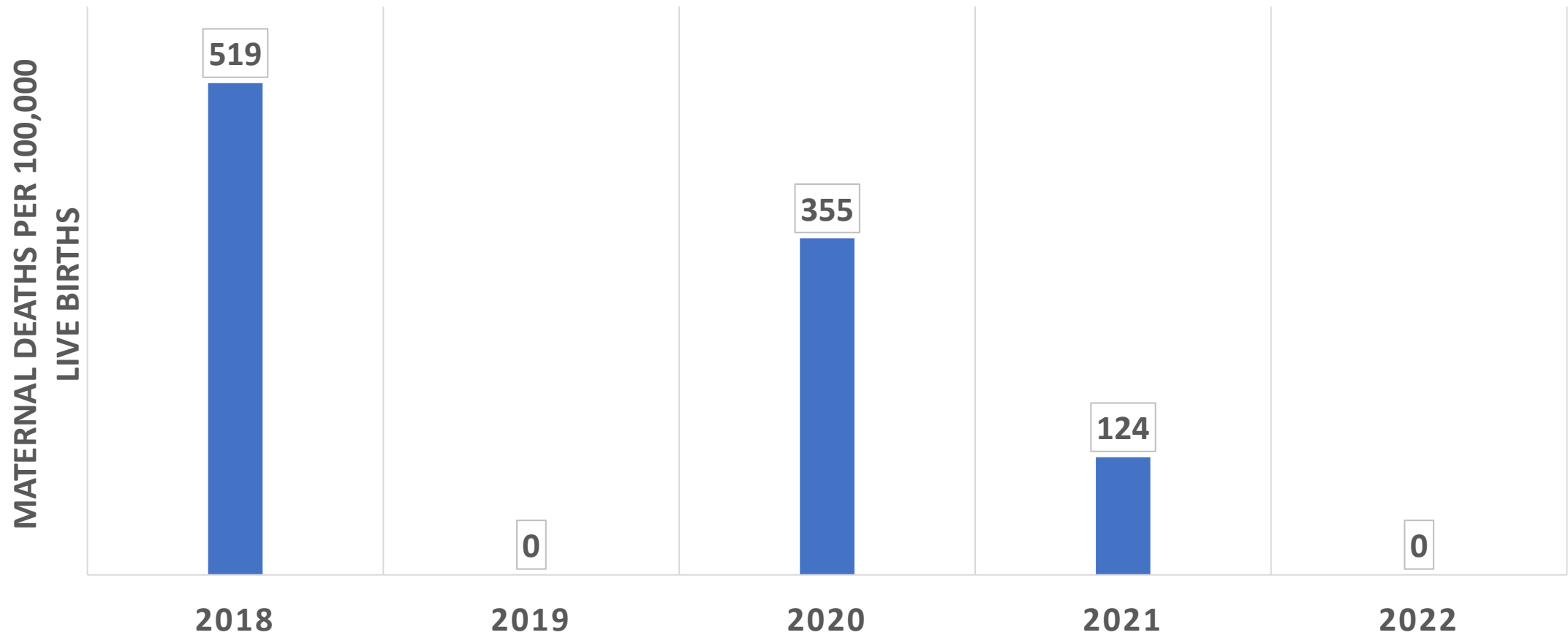
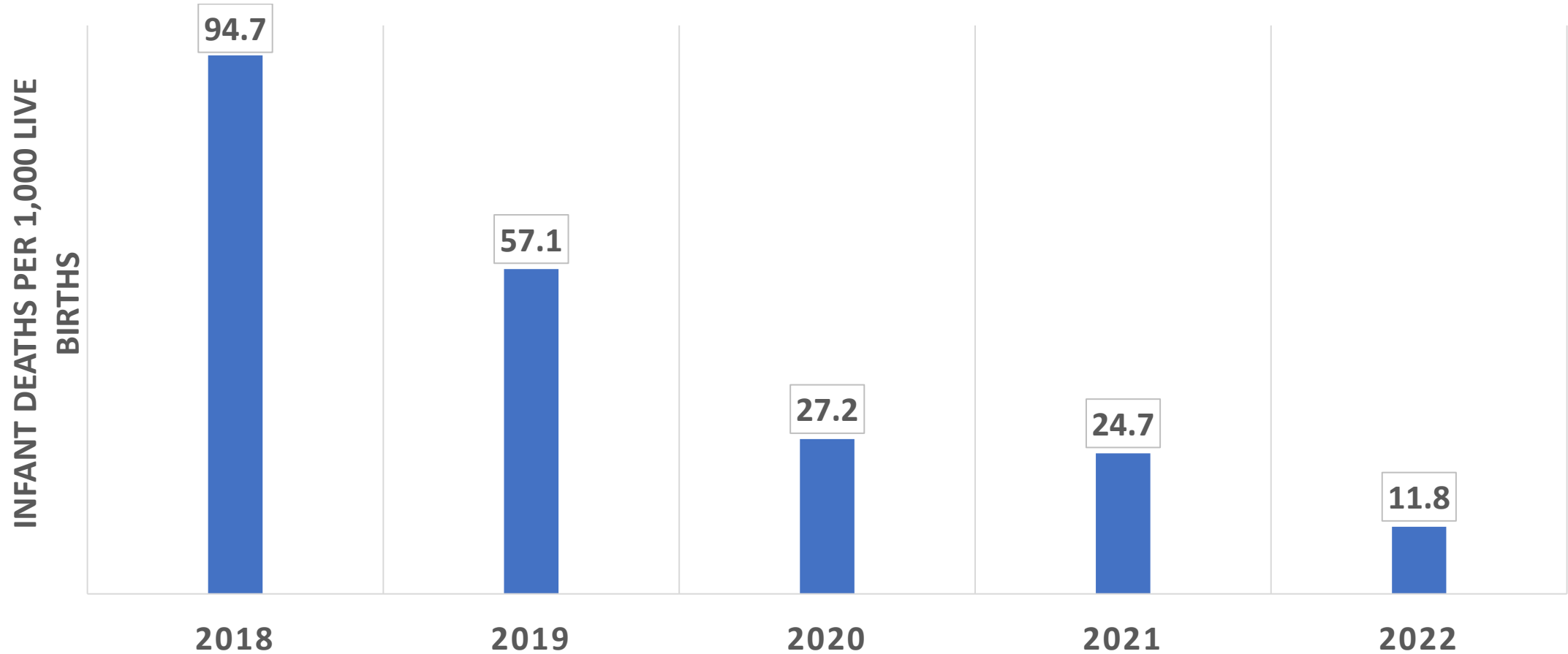


Fig. 1 Changes in stunting of under-2 children in the Curamericas/Guatemala Project Area and under-2 children in comparison areas, 1999–2016. Note: The baseline values for the data from the comparison areas were collected in 1999

Decline of infant mortality in the Curamericas/Guatemala project area, 2018-2022



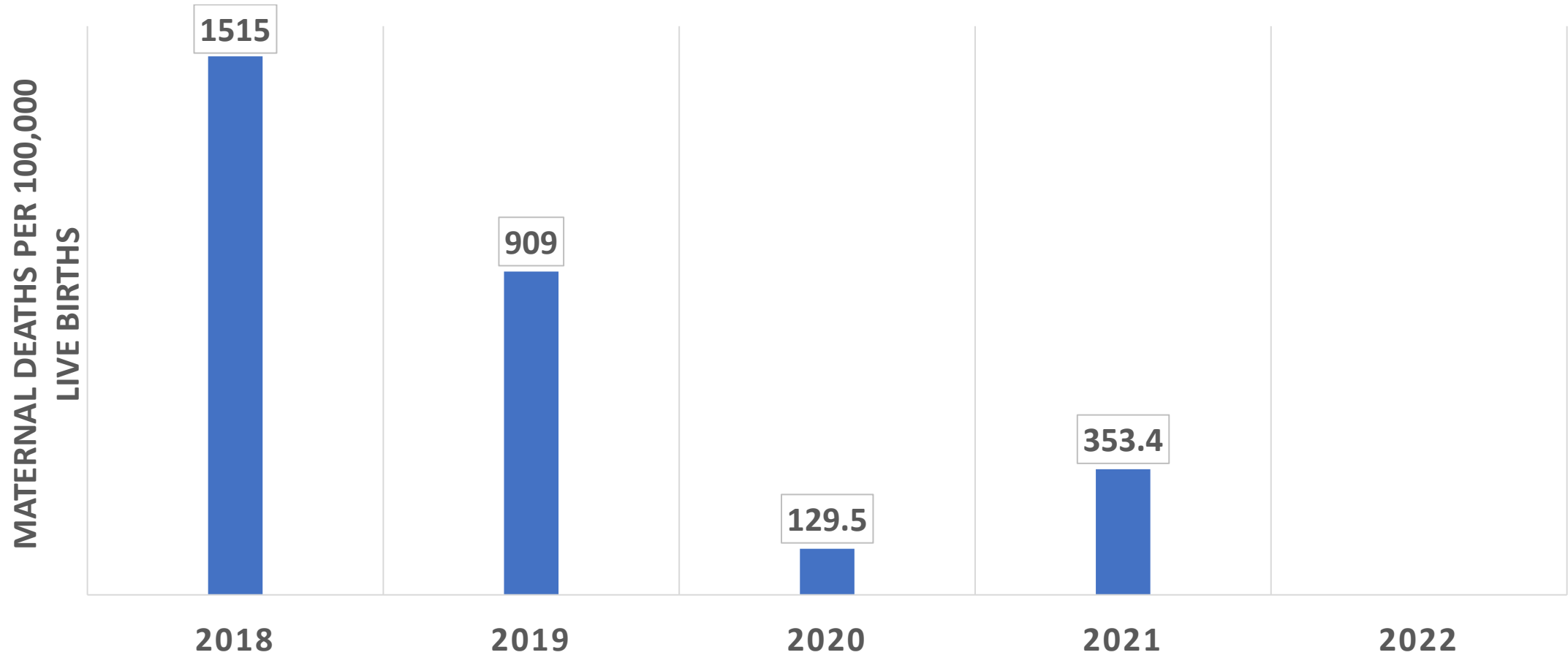
Liberia
